Strong boards reflect on their own practices, celebrate achievements, and create plans around identified growth areas. Based on your annual board evaluation, develop a learning plan that addresses your boards' prioritized needs. This worksheet was inspired by the learning plan of the PEPS board in Seattle.

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A board learning plan should include three areas:

- Learning about your organization (programs, services, etc.)
- Learning about nonprofit practices (finance, advocacy, fundraising, etc.)
- Learning about the larger cause in which your nonprofit is working
