CDCAC - all required guidelines, staff needs proof of vaccination, will be returning to staff masking Monday. Clients screened at front door.

Mount Baker Theatre is requiring everyone masked, proof of vaccination or test before entering theatre event.

MBT - Yes and yes.

Women & Children's Free Restaurant-Yes. No outside guests in the building, distancing, travel quarantine time, masks. Have loosened this now since all staff and volunteers are required to be vaccinated.

CDCAC - Yes, everyone entering the building must be masked. Staff fills out vaccine confirmation which is on file with HR.

Many are still implementing social distancing, extra cleaning, masks, etc.

Online programs only at this time, but will require volunteers to be vaccinated when volunteers return onsite. Staff and others entering the facility must wear masks onsite. Takes temperatures (staff, clients, etc) when coming onsite

Most require masks (some only for non-vaccinated folks).

Some nonprofits are requiring vaccination proof (either storing vaccination card image, requiring a self-attestation, or having a staff member view the vaccination proof & noting the confirmation for each volunteer).
